MISSOURI ELECTIONS NOVEMBER 7, 2023

Last Updated: October 16, 2023

Election(s): Special Election in a few, not all, jurisdictions.

District(s): Missouri's elections are decentralized, and the state is composed of 116 local election jurisdictions. Under Missouri law, in odd number years, counties, cities, fire districts, and school districts have the option to call for a special election if necessary. **Due to the decentralized management of Missouri's elections, it is important to reach out to <u>local election officials</u> to determine whether there is an election in the relevant jurisdiction and, if there is, what is on the ballot.**

Who Can Vote? If a voter says their polling place is not open, check with <u>local election</u> <u>officials</u> to determine if there is an election in the relevant jurisdiction on and, if so, where the voter should vote.

Eday Polling Hours: Polls open at 6 AM and close at 7 PM CDT.

Notable Changes from FAQs:

The first part of FAQ 17. **IDENTIFICATION** should be modified to read (change is highlighted in the text):

Missouri voters must show one of the following forms of photo ID to vote in-person absentee or in person at the polls:

- Non-expired Missouri Driver's license or nondriver's license;
- A non-expired document issued by either the United States (such as a passport) or Missouri which shows a photograph of the voter, contains the name of the voter which matches the most recent signature in the voter's registration record, includes an expiration date;
- Any photo ID issued by the Missouri National Guard, the U.S. Armed Forces (including the Space Force), or the U.S. Department of Veteran Affairs that is not expired or does not have an expiration date.

If the driver or non-driver license has expired after the most recent general election (**November 8, 2022**), it is an acceptable form of voter ID.

In addition, the "**Note to hotline volunteer**" at the bottom of both FAQ 17 and FAQ 18 should be ignored as the litigation referenced has been resolved and the photo ID law is in effect.

Other Information:

There will not be any state-wide or federal issues on November ballots in Missouri. The best source of information on whether there is an election in a particular jurisdiction will be <u>local election officials</u>.
