## Important Tips

Login / Access	Login through <u>electionprotection.okta.com</u> login access starts the day before your shift. Please do not try to login earlier, you won't be able to and will run into password issues later.
Starting your shift	<ul> <li>Divide responsibilities between your co-captains</li> <li>Review the captain's log (the password for Captains Home is 2024Captains)</li> <li>Greet volunteers as they arrive and confirm they have signed the code of conduct</li> </ul>
Giving Guidance	<ul> <li>Be present and responsive for volunteers</li> <li>Responses do not have to be answers, but all volunteers should quickly get a response to their question.</li> </ul>
How do I	Click "How Do I" on the top menu of the EP Legal guidance platform for quick technical guides.
